

Horizon vs M&R Diamondback

- 1) All Anatol Equipment comes with a 2 year parts and labor warranty. The Diamondback has a 1 year parts/ 30 day labor warranty. For an additional charge you can upgrade to 2 years. I'm not sure if that's just parts or not.
- 2) The Horizon comes with pneumatic screen clamps standard. The Diamondback has it as an option.
- 3) The Horizon can use 20"x24" screens. The Diamondback can not.
- 4) The Horizon can run 700 shirts per hour. The Diamondback will not exceed 450.
- 5) The Horizon's "off contact" adjuster is adjustable with a 3/8" range by .005" increments. The Diamondback only has a 3 position factory set adjuster.
- 6) The Horizon has quick release (tool-less) squeegee and flood bars. The Diamondback needs tools to change them.
- 7) The Horizon has front and rear stroke adjustment. The Diamondback only has rear adjustment.
- 8) The Horizon pallets are rubber coated aluminum. The Diamondback pallets are "composite". On the rest of their automatics, they use rubber coated aluminum.
- 9) The horizon has front and rear shock absorbers. The Diamondback has bumpers.
- 10) The Horizon has a user friendly touch pad control. The Diamondback has an expensive/ hard to navigate touch screen control.
