

## INKSCAPE GENERAL DIRECTIONS

1. Import your image into Inkscape. You can drag and drop your image to the Inkscape desktop or Click File>Import, find your file and click OK.
2. Select the image, go to the top of the screen, click Path>Trace Bitmap.
3. The Trace Bitmap menu will then open. Here you can select how you want your image vectorized and adjust the settings. You can also generate a preview. Once you are happy with the preview click OK and close the Trace Bitmap screen.X
4. Now you will have your new vector image and the old raster (bitmap, jpeg, gif etc) image stacked on top of each other. Separate the two and delete the raster.X
5. Play around with your new vector image!

6. If you need to break it apart in Inkscape, Path> Break Apart. This may fill in some with black, but ok for now .
7. Then Click the entire group (still grouped) and click the icon on top for Ungroup Selected Groups.
8. Now do any recoloring necessary to put back to white again

9. Save out as .SVG
10. Open in CorelDraw
11. Unlock
12. Ungroup All
13. Now manipulate as necessary as everything should be ungrouped and changeable.
